Art Ehuan is currently a Director with Forward Discovery, Inc, an Information Security provider with offices in Washington DC, Texas, North Carolina and Delaware. Art specializes in digital forensics, e-discovery and data protection strategic advisory services to corporate and government agencies. He provides domestic and global thought leadership and also serves as a senior lecturer on cyber crime and digital forensics for the United States Department of State.

Art previously served as Assistant VP and Director of the Corporate Information Security Department for USAA, a Fortune 200 financial services company. In this role, he was responsible for worldwide enterprise strategic guidance on the protection of USAA information. During his tenure, he also established USAA's digital forensic capability and developed their Advanced Data Security and Incident Reporting programs. Previously, Art was Deputy Chief Information Security Officer for Northrop Grumman Corporation's (NGC) Information Security Directorate. In this capacity, he was responsible for protecting NGC from information system threats from both internal and external sources and for developing and managing security operations including methodology, infrastructure patterns and e-business best practices. Art also served as Manager with the Federal Information Security Team for BearingPoint (Formerly KPMG Consulting) in McLean, VA where he established information security initiatives and solutions for government agencies and private industry, as well as developed BearingPoint's corporate incident response and digital forensic services. Art was former Program Manager for Cisco Systems Information Security where he directed securing corporate networks, managing risk assessments and protection of source code. He also established worldwide digital forensic capability for Cisco Systems.

Art has widespread experience working with law enforcement officers in the United States and internationally on computer crime cases. He has an extensive background in conducting and managing computer intrusion and forensic investigations with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). His last assignment was as Supervisory Special Agent assigned to the Computer Crime Investigations Program at FBI Headquarters, Washington DC. He served as Computer Analysis Response Team (CART) certified examiner and also developed and conducted training for law enforcement globally. Art is also a former Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI) computer crime Special Agent who has investigated cyber crime against US Department of Defense network systems. He has testified in Federal, Military and State courts on digital forensics.

Art is a Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP); Cisco Certified Network Professional (CCNP) + Security; Cisco Certified Design Professional (CCDP); Certified Forensics Computer Examiner (CFCE) and National Security Agency (NSA) Information Assessment Methodology (IAM). Art is also an Adjunct professor at George Washington and previously taught at Georgetown and Duke University. He is a speaker to both government and private industry on topics including enterprise risk, computer crime/forensics, e-Discovery and information protection.
